NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT IN MANITOBA DEVELOPMENTAL CENTRE CLASS ACTION

To all persons who resided at the Manitoba Developmental Centre ("MDC") during the period between July 1, 1951 and May 29, 2020, and who were alive as of October 31, 2016

A proposed settlement has been reached in this case. While no admission of liability is made and none of the allegations have been proven, this proposed settlement, if approved, will make compensation available to eligible Class Members who suffered harms while living at MDC.

There will be a court hearing on **May 5, 2023** to decide whether the proposed settlement should be approved.

The proposed settlement includes a fund of \$17 million for compensation to Class Members, and several reconciliation initiatives. Class Members will be able to claim between \$3,000 and \$85,000 in compensation for harms suffered.

You cannot make a claim yet. If the Court approves the settlement and you are part of the lawsuit as a Class Member, you can then make a claim for compensation.

If you opted out of the class action, the settlement does not impact you and you cannot submit a claim for compensation or take a position in response to the settlement.
